BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health - General 14 [21–342. 15 16 A person may not keep for sale: 17 (1) Any unfrozen crab meat at a temperature that exceeds 45 degrees 18 Fahrenheit: 19 (2)Any frozen crab meat at a temperature that exceeds 0 degrees 20 Fahrenheit: or 21 (3)Any pasteurized crab meat at a temperature that exceeds 38 degrees 22 Fahrenheit.



SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
