BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health - General [21–342. A person may not keep for sale: Any unfrozen crab meat at a temperature that exceeds 45 degrees (1) Fahrenheit;
