1 AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws – School Bus Monitoring Cameras – Civil Penalty

- FOR the purpose of altering the civil penalty for a violation recorded by a school bus monitoring camera for failure to stop for a school vehicle operating alternately flashing red lights; repealing a requirement that the District Court prescribe a certain civil penalty; and generally relating to civil penalties for violations recorded by school bus monitoring cameras.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

(a) If a school vehicle has stopped on a roadway and is operating the alternately
flashing red lights specified in § 22–228 of this article, the driver of any other vehicle
meeting or overtaking the school vehicle shall stop at least 20 feet from the rear of the

school vehicle, if approaching the school vehicle from its rear, or at least 20 feet from thefront of the school vehicle, if approaching the school vehicle from its front.

3 (b) If a school vehicle has stopped on a roadway and is operating the alternately 4 flashing red lights specified in § 22–228 of this article, the driver of any other vehicle 5 meeting or overtaking the school vehicle may not proceed until the school vehicle resumes 6 motion or the alternately flashing red lights are deactivated.

7 (c) This section does not apply to the driver of a vehicle on a divided highway, if 8 the school vehicle is on a different roadway.

10 (a) (b) "Violation" means a violation of § 21–706 of this subtitle.

11 (e) (1) Unless the driver of the motor vehicle received a citation from a police 12 officer at the time of the violation, the owner or, in accordance with subsection (h)(5) of this 13 section, the driver of a motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty if the motor vehicle is 14 recorded by a school bus monitoring camera during the commission of a violation.

- 15 (2) [A] **THE** civil penalty under this subsection [may not exceed] IS \$250.
- 16 (3) For purposes of this section, the District Court shall [prescribe]:

17 (i) [A] **PRESCRIBE** A uniform citation form consistent with 18 subsection (f)(1) of this section and § 7–302 of the Courts Article; and

(ii) [A civil penalty, which shall be indicated] INDICATE THE CIVIL
 PENALTY on the citation, to be paid by persons who choose to prepay the civil penalty
 without appearing in District Court.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2017.
