## Baltimore County - Elections for Judges of the Orphans' Court - Procedures

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that certain provisions of law govern the nomination and 4 election of judges of the orphans' court in Baltimore County; authorizing a candidate 5 for judge of the orphans' court in Baltimore County to file and appear on certain 6 primary election ballots; requiring that certain candidates appear on the general 7 election ballot; prohibiting the political affiliation of certain candidates from being 8 included on the general election ballot; providing for the application of certain 9 provisions of this Act; making a conforming change; and generally relating to the procedures for the election of judges of the orphans' court in Baltimore County. 10
