1 AN ACT concerning

Adult Entertainment Establishments – National Human Trafficking Resource Center Hotline Information – Sign Posting Requirements

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the owner of a certain adult entertainment establishment to post a certain information sign in each restroom of the adult entertainment $\mathbf{5}$ 6 establishment in a certain manner; requiring a certain agency that determines a 7 certain violation has occurred to notify the owner of the adult entertainment 8 establishment or the owner's agent of the violation; providing that the owner is 9 subject to a certain civil penalty if the owner does not post certain signs within a certain period of time after receiving a certain notice; defining certain terms; and 10 generally relating to posting signs with information about the National Human 11 12Trafficking Resource Center Hotline in adult entertainment establishments.

(2) "ADULT ENTERTAINMENT" MEANS LIVE ENTERTAINMENT: 3 4 (I) (I): IN WHICH INDIVIDUALS APPEAR FOR PUBLIC VIEW IN A STATE OF NUDITY OR PARTIAL NUDITY; OR; $\mathbf{5}$ 6 THAT IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE SEXUAL STIMULATION OR (III) $\overline{7}$ **SEXUAL GRATIFICATION;** 8 (HII) THAT IS DISTINGUISHED OR CHARACTERIZED BY AN 9 EMPHASIS ON MATERIAL THAT DEPICTS, DESCRIBES, OR RELATES TO: 10 1. 1 (b) (1) The owner of a privately owned bus station [or], truck stop, OR ADULT 2 ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT shall post the National Human Trafficking Resource 3 Center Hotline information sign described in § 15–207 of this article in each restroom of 4 the bus station [or], truck stop, OR ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT.

- 5 (2) A sign required under this section shall be posted:
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(i) on the inside of each stall door in the restroom; or

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(ii) on the back of the door at the entrance to the restroom.

8 (c) (1) An agency that enforces this section and determines that a violation of 9 this section has occurred shall notify the business owner of the bus station [or], truck stop, 10 **OR ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT**, or the business owner's agent, of the 11 violation.

12 (2) If the business owner of the bus station [or], truck stop, OR ADULT 13 ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT does not post signs as required under this section 14 within 24 hours after receiving the notice required under paragraph (1) of this subsection, 15 the business owner is subject to a civil penalty not exceeding \$1,000.

16 (3) For each restroom in which a business owner fails to post a sign in 17 accordance with this section, the business owner is subject to a separate civil penalty.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2017.
