CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Cownose Ray Fishing Tournaments - Prohibition Fishery Management Plan 3 and Moratorium on Tournaments

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from organizing, sponsoring, promoting, 5 conducting, or participating in a cownose ray fishing tournament in State waters: 6 requiring the Secretary of Natural Resources to adopt certain regulations; defining 7 a certain term; and generally relating to cownose ray fishing tournaments requiring the Department of Natural Resources to prepare a certain fishery management plan 8 9 for the cownose ray species on or before a certain date; prohibiting a person from 10 organizing, sponsoring, promoting, conducting, or participating in a certain cownose 11 ray fishing tournament in State waters until a certain date; making this Act an 12 emergency measure; and generally relating to the cownose ray fishery.

20 21 22 23	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before December 31, 2017, the Department of Natural Resources shall prepare the cownose ray fishery management plan required by § 4–215(b)(25) of the Natural Resources Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.
24	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
25 26	(a) In this section, "cownose ray fishing tournament" means any tournament contest, competition, or derby with the objective of catching or killing cownose rays for:
27	(1) prizes or other inducements; or
28	(2) entertainment purposes.

Until July 1, 2018, a person may not organize, sponsor, promote, conduct, or

That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
