(A) The Secretary shall develop a statewide information technology master plan. (B) **(1)** THE STATEWIDE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MASTER PLAN DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A CYBERSECURITY FRAMEWORK.
