FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "sexual abuse" in provisions of law relating to

terms "sexual molestation or exploitation" and "sex trafficking" in provisions of law
relating to child abuse; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally
relating to child abuse and sex trafficking.
