- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

15 (a) An individual may not drive a school vehicle on any highway in this State 16 unless the individual:

17 (1) Passes an appropriate medical examination; and

18 (2) For driving a school bus, has been issued a commercial driver's license19 [endorsed school bus].

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2017.
