- 1 (b) (1) "Annuity contract" means a fixed or variable annuity contract or combination of fixed or variable annuity contracts authorized under § 403(a) or (b) of the 3 Internal Revenue Code.
- 4 (2) "Annuity contract" includes a custodial account to be invested in 5 regulated investment company stock as provided in § 401(f) or § 403(b)(7) of the Internal 6 Revenue Code.
- 7 (d) "Eligible employee" means an individual eligible to participate in the program.
- 8 (f) "Participating employee" means an eligible employee who elects to participate 9 in the program.
