- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

12 (e) If there are no surviving dependents and, on the date of death, the covered 13 employee did not have a legal obligation to support a surviving spouse, the right to 14 compensation survives only to the surviving minor children of the covered employee.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to 16 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or 17 application to any claim arising from events occurring before the effective date of this Act.

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2017.
