1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Lottery Tickets – Internet Sales – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency from
4 allowing *the establishment of any system or program that allows* a person to purchase
5 a State lottery ticket through an electronic device that connects to the Internet; and
6 generally relating to the sale of State lottery tickets.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
5 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – State Government**

7 9–101.

8 (b) “Agency” means the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency.

9 9–111.

10 **(E) THE AGENCY MAY NOT ALLOW THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ANY SYSTEM OR**
11 **PROGRAM THAT ALLOWS A PERSON TO PURCHASE A STATE LOTTERY TICKET**
12 **THROUGH AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE THAT CONNECTS TO THE INTERNET, SUCH AS A**
13 **PERSONAL COMPUTER OR MOBILE DEVICE.**

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2017.
