17(1) TO AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT OR A SIMILAR DOCUMENT OR18AGREEMENT CONCERNING AN EMPLOYEE WHO EARNS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN:

- 19 (I) **\$15** PER HOUR; OR
- 20 (II) \$31,200 ANNUALLY; AND

1 (2) WHETHER OR NOT THE EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE ENTERED INTO 2 THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT OR SIMILAR DOCUMENT OR AGREEMENT IN THE 3 STATE.

4 (B) A NONCOMPETE OR CONFLICT OF INTEREST PROVISION IN AN 5 EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT OR A SIMILAR DOCUMENT OR AGREEMENT THAT 6 RESTRICTS THE ABILITY OF AN EMPLOYEE TO ENTER INTO EMPLOYMENT WITH A 7 NEW EMPLOYER OR TO BECOME SELF-EMPLOYED IN THE SAME OR SIMILAR 8 BUSINESS OR TRADE SHALL BE NULL AND VOID AS BEING AGAINST THE PUBLIC 9 POLICY OF THE STATE.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2017.
