- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County Public School System to establish an 5 assessment process to evaluate the academic achievement and readiness of 6 applicants for admission to a middle school magnet program in the Baltimore County 7 Public School System and to include only those applicants who demonstrate high 8 academic achievement and readiness for enrollment in a magnet program in the 9 lottery that selects students to be admitted to a middle school magnet program; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Baltimore County Public School 10 11 System middle school magnet program.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "MAGNET PROGRAM" MEANS A THEME-RELATED
- 22 CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM IN THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC
- 23 SCHOOL SYSTEM THAT:

- 1 (1) IS NOT AVAILABLE AS A COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL PROGRAM
- 2 **OPTION**;
- 3 (2) SERVES AS AN INCUBATOR FOR INNOVATIVE INSTRUCTIONAL
- 4 PRACTICES;
- 5 (3) IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE-RATED SCHOOL BUILDING
- 6 CAPACITY, DRAWS STUDENTS FROM ACROSS STUDENT ATTENDANCE BOUNDARIES;
- 7 AND
- 8 (4) IS ACCESSED THROUGH A CENTRALIZED STUDENT APPLICATION
- 9 AND ADMISSION PROCESS.
- 10 (B) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL:
- 11 (1) ESTABLISH AN ASSESSMENT PROCESS TO EVALUATE THE
- 12 ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AND READINESS OF EACH STUDENT APPLYING FOR
- 13 ADMISSION TO A MIDDLE SCHOOL MAGNET PROGRAM; AND
- 14 (2) INCLUDE ONLY THOSE APPLICANTS WHO DEMONSTRATE HIGH
- 15 ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AND READINESS FOR ENROLLMENT IN A MIDDLE SCHOOL
- 16 MAGNET PROGRAM IN THE LOTTERY FOR THE SELECTION OF THE STUDENTS TO BE
- 17 OFFERED ADMISSION TO A MIDDLE SCHOOL MAGNET PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 19 1, 2017.
