3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in 4 consultation with stakeholders, to identify certain information about perinatal mood 5 and anxiety disorders; requiring the Department to make available certain 6 information on the Department's Web site and to provide certain information to 7 certain health care facilities and certain health care providers; requiring the 8 Department, in collaboration with certain professional associations and public 9 health entities, to identify and develop certain training programs; requiring the 10 Department to identify methods develop a plan to expand the Maryland Behavioral 11 Health Integration in Pediatric Primary Care Program (BHIPP) program for a 12 certain purpose; requiring the Department, in collaboration with certain affected stakeholders, to develop the plan; requiring the Department, in developing the plan, 13 14 to identify and address certain issues; requiring the Department to submit the plan 15 to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; defining 16 certain terms; and generally relating to maternal mental health.
