5 6	(a) In this section, "accessory items" includes jewelry, watches, watchbands, handbags, handkerchiefs, umbrellas, scarves, ties, headbands, and belt buckles.		
7 8 9 10	(b) (1) Beginning in calendar year 2010, the 7-day period from the second Sunday in August through the following Saturday shall be a tax-free period for back-to-school shopping in Maryland during which the exemption under paragraph (2) of this subsection shall apply.		
11 12	(2) During the tax-free period for back-to-school shopping established under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the sales and use tax does not apply to the sale of:		
13 14	(I) <u>THE SALE OF</u> any item of clothing or footwear, excluding accessory items, if the taxable price of the item of clothing or footwear is \$100 or less; OR		
15 16 17	(II) <u>THE FIRST \$50</u> \$40 OF THE TAXABLE PRICE OF ANY BACKPACK OR BOOKBAG, IF THE TAXABLE PRICE OF THE BACKPACK OR BOOKBAG IS \$100 \$30 OR LESS.
