- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain fines to be remitted to the Animal Abuse Emergency Compensation Fund; establishing the Animal Abuse Emergency Compensation 4 5 Fund; providing for the uses, purposes, sources of funding, investment of money, and 6 auditing of the Fund; requiring the Executive Director of the Governor's Office of 7 Crime Control and Prevention (GOCCP) to administer the Fund; providing that the 8 Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund not subject to certain provisions of law; 9 requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; exempting the 10 Fund from a certain provision of law requiring interest on State money in special 11 funds to accrue to the General Fund of the State; defining certain terms; providing 12 for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Animal Abuse 13 Emergency Compensation Fund.


