## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Allegheny County – Sheriff’s Deputies – Salary and Duties**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of a Sheriff’s deputy in Allegheny County; clarifying  
4 that at least one of the Sheriff’s deputies is required to be assigned to certain duties;  
5 and generally relating to Sheriff’s deputies in Allegheny County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings  
8 Section 2–309(b)(2)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2013 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 2–309.

15 (b) (2) The Sheriff shall appoint not less than five deputies at salaries [of at  
16 least \$2,400 each] **DETERMINED BY THE SHERIFF’S BUDGET** who are under the county  
17 classified service; **AT LEAST** one of these deputies shall be assigned by the Sheriff to execute  
18 process, orders, and directions for the juvenile court, and to perform the other duties the  
19 Sheriff assigns.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 2017.
