SENATE BILL 738

- A. Any Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit resident in St. Mary's County may appoint a competent secretary who shall have had some previous experience in secretarial work, involving duties that demonstrate the ability to make rapid and accurate transcripts and to exercise independent judgement. The secretary may serve as a deputy to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County.
- B. The salary for the secretary shall be paid by the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County. The compensation paid by the County Commissioners shall be levied annually by the County Commissioners of said County and charged to the expenses of the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2017.
