SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - Tax - Property

9-102.
(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
(2) (i) "Assets" include:

1. real property;
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.
2. cash;
3. savings accounts;
4. stocks;
5. bonds; and
6. any other investment.
(ii) "Assets" do not include:
7. the cash value of the life insurance policies on the life of the renter; [or]

## 2. THE CASH VALUE OF ANY QUALIFIED RETIREMENT

 SAVINGS PLANS OR INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS; OR[2.] 3. tangible personal property.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2017, and shall be applicable to all calendar years beginning after December 31, 2016.
