## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Cecil County – Alcoholic Beverages – Beer, Wine, and Liquor Tasting License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a beer, wine, and liquor tasting license in Cecil County; 4 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Cecil County to issue the beer,  $\mathbf{5}$ wine, and liquor tasting license to a certain license holder; authorizing the license 6 holder to allow on-premises consumption of beer, wine, and liquor for tasting; specifying the term of the license; requiring a license holder to provide certain notice 7 8 before exercising certain privileges; specifying the amount of beer, wine, and liquor 9 that an individual may sample at each offering; specifying certain license fees; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Cecil County. 10

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article – Alcoholic Beverages

2 Title 4, Subtitle 12 ("Temporary Licenses") of Division I of this article applies in the 3 county without exception or variation.

5 (A) THERE IS A BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR TASTING LICENSE.

# 6 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS A OR 7 CLASS B BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

8 (C) (1) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO ALLOW ON-PREMISES 9 CONSUMPTION OF BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR TASTING.

- 10 (2) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR A MAXIMUM OF:
- 11 (I) ANY 26 DAYS IN A LICENSING PERIOD;
- 12 (II) ANY 52 DAYS IN A LICENSING PERIOD; OR
- 13 (III) AN ENTIRE LICENSING PERIOD.

14 (3) IF A LICENSE HOLDER IS ISSUED A LICENSE FOR ANY 26 DAYS IN A
15 LICENSING PERIOD OR ANY 52 DAYS IN A LICENSING PERIOD, THE LICENSE HOLDER
16 SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD AT LEAST 7 DAYS BEFORE EXERCISING THE PRIVILEGES
17 OF THE LICENSE.

18 **(D)** AN INDIVIDUAL MAY CONSUME BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR COVERED BY 19 THE LICENSE IN A QUANTITY OF NOT MORE THAN:

- 20 (1) 1 OUNCE FROM EACH OFFERING OF BEER OR WINE; AND
- 21 (2) ONE-HALF OUNCE FROM EACH OFFERING OF LIQUOR.

22 (E) IN ADDITION TO THE COST OF A CLASS A OR CLASS B BEER, WINE, AND 23 LIQUOR LICENSE, THE LICENSE FEE IS:

- 24 (1) \$125 FOR A 26–DAY LICENSE;
- 25 (2) \$200 FOR A 52–DAY LICENSE; AND
- 26 (3) \$400 FOR A 1–YEAR LICENSE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 1, 2017.
