BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Public Utilities 7-207.(b) (3) Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, unless a (i) certificate of public convenience and necessity for the construction is first obtained from the Commission, a person may not begin construction of an overhead transmission line that is

- designed to carry a voltage in excess of 69,000 volts or exercise a right of condemnation with the construction.
- 3 (ii) For construction related to an existing overhead transmission 4 line, the Commission may waive the requirement in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph for 5 good cause.
 - (iii) Notwithstanding subparagraph (i) of this paragraph and subject to subparagraph (iv) of this paragraph, the Commission may issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the construction of an overhead transmission line only if the applicant for the certificate of public convenience and necessity:
