1 AN ACT concerning

State Board of Physicians – Physician Licensure – Prohibition on Requiring Specialty Certification

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Board of Physicians from requiring, as a
qualification to obtain a license or as a condition to renew a license, certification by
a certain accrediting organization that specializes in a specific area of medicine or
maintenance of certification by a certain accrediting organization that includes
certain reexamination as a requirement for maintaining certification; and generally
relating to physician licensure by the State Board of Physicians.

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SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Health Occupations

5 (D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE BOARD MAY NOT REQUIRE AS 6 A QUALIFICATION TO OBTAIN A LICENSE OR AS A CONDITION TO RENEW A LICENSE:

7 (1) CERTIFICATION BY A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED ACCREDITING 8 ORGANIZATION THAT SPECIALIZES IN A SPECIFIC AREA OF MEDICINE; OR

9 (2) MAINTENANCE OF CERTIFICATION BY Α NATIONALLY 10 **RECOGNIZED ACCREDITING ORGANIZATION THAT SPECIALIZES IN A SPECIFIC AREA** OF MEDICINE THAT INCLUDES CONTINUOUS REEXAMINATION TO MEASURE CORE 11 12COMPETENCIES IN THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE AS A REQUIREMENT FOR 13 MAINTAINING CERTIFICATION.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2017.
