2 Health Insurance – Volunteer Emergency Responders – Benefits Under Blanket 3 Policies and Contracts

- 4 FOR the purpose of excluding, from certain provisions of State insurance laws, certain 5 blanket health insurance policies and contracts that provide health insurance 6 benefits to certain volunteer emergency responders; providing that the blanket 7 health insurance policies and contracts are subject to certain provisions of State 8 insurance laws; requiring the blanket health insurance policies and contracts to 9 disclose that the policies and contracts do not provide comprehensive health coverage: defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and 10 11 generally relating to blanket health insurance policies and contracts that provide 12 health benefits to volunteer emergency responders.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
 (b) "Blanket health insurance" means the form of health insurance described in § 15–305 of this subtitle.
 15–305.
- 5 (a) (1) Blanket health insurance is health insurance issued to or in the name 6 of persons specified in this section to cover the groups of individuals described in this 7 section.
- 8 (2) The person to which or in the name of which a policy or contract is 9 issued is deemed the policyholder.
- 10 (g) A policy or contract of blanket health insurance may be issued in the name of 11 a volunteer fire department, first aid group, other similar volunteer group, or agency with 12 jurisdiction over a volunteer fire department, first aid group, or other similar volunteer 13 group, to cover all members of the volunteer fire department or similar volunteer group.

- 15 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 16 INDICATED.
- 17 (2) "BLANKET HEALTH INSURANCE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 18 15–301 OF THIS TITLE.
- 19 (3) (I) "EMERGENCY RESPONDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS 20 AN ACTIVE VOLUNTEER MEMBER OF AN EMERGENCY SERVICES ORGANIZATION.
- 21 (II) "EMERGENCY RESPONDER" INCLUDES A FIREFIGHTER, AN 22 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, AND ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A BONA 23 FIDE VOLUNTEER AS DEFINED IN § 457(E) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.
- 24 (4) (I) "EMERGENCY SERVICES ORGANIZATION" MEANS AN 25 ORGANIZATION THAT TAKES IMMEDIATE ACTION TO DEAL WITH AN EMERGENCY.
- 26 (II) "EMERGENCY SERVICES ORGANIZATION" INCLUDES A 27 VOLUNTEER:
- 28 1. FIRE DEPARTMENT;
- 29 **2.** FIRST AID ORGANIZATION; AND

1	3.	AMBULANCE AND RESCUE ORGANIZATION.

- 2 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A POLICY OR CONTRACT OF BLANKET 3 HEALTH INSURANCE THAT PROVIDES HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS TO
- 4 EMERGENCY RESPONDERS:
- 5 (1) FOR AN INJURY TO OR SICKNESS OF AN EMERGENCY RESPONDER;
- 6 AND
- 7 (2) THAT OCCURS WHEN, OR AS A RESULT OF, PERFORMING DUTIES 8 OR ACTIVITIES ON BEHALF OF OR AT THE DIRECTION OF:
- 9 (I) A VOLUNTEER EMERGENCY SERVICES ORGANIZATION; OR
- 10 (II) AN AUTHORITY THAT HAS JURISDICTION OVER STATE 11 EMERGENCY SERVICES ORGANIZATIONS.
- 12 (C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
 13 POLICY OR CONTRACT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO THIS TITLE.
- 14 (2) A POLICY OR CONTRACT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO SUBTITLE 4 OR SUBTITLE 8 OF THIS TITLE, EXCEPT § 15–833.
- 16 (D) A POLICY OR CONTRACT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL DISCLOSE
 17 THAT THE POLICY OR CONTRACT DOES NOT PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH
 18 COVERAGE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all policies or contracts of blanket health insurance subject to Section 1 of this Act that are issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after October 1, 2017.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
