## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Procurement Preferences – Blind Industries and Services of Maryland –**  
3 **Janitorial Products**

4 FOR the purpose of clarifying that the requirement that a State or State aided or controlled  
5 entity include in certain maintenance contracts a requirement that a prime  
6 contractor procure certain products from the Blind Industries and Services of  
7 Maryland under certain circumstances applies to products made or manufactured by  
8 the Blind Industries and Services of Maryland; providing for the application of a  
9 certain provision of law; and generally relating to procurement preferences related  
10 to the Blind Industries and Services of Maryland.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Article – State Finance and Procurement

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

19 14–103.

20 (a) A State or State aided or controlled entity shall buy supplies and services  
21 from:

22 (1) Maryland Correctional Enterprises, as provided in Title 3, Subtitle 5 of  
23 the Correctional Services Article, if Maryland Correctional Enterprises provides the  
24 supplies or services;

1 (2) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland, if:

2 (i) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland provides the supplies  
3 or services; and

4 (ii) Maryland Correctional Enterprises does not provide the supplies  
5 or services; or

6 (3) the Employment Works Program established under § 14–108 of this  
7 subtitle, if:

8 (i) a community service provider or an individual with disability  
9 owned business provides the supplies or services;

10 (ii) neither Maryland Correctional Enterprises nor Blind Industries  
11 and Services of Maryland provides the supplies or services; and

12 (iii) the State or a State aided or controlled entity is not required by  
13 law to buy the supplies or services from any other unit of the State government.

14 (b) A State or State aided or controlled entity shall give preference to the  
15 providers listed under subsection (a) of this section in the order that the providers are listed.

16 (c) **(1)** To the extent practicable, a State or State aided or controlled entity  
17 shall include in a maintenance contract that has a component for housekeeping or janitorial  
18 services, a requirement that a prime contractor procure janitorial products from Blind  
19 Industries and Services of Maryland [when] **IF** the specified products **ARE MADE OR**  
20 **MANUFACTURED BY BLIND INDUSTRIES AND SERVICES OF MARYLAND AND** are  
21 available.

22 **(2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY**  
23 **PRODUCT THAT BLIND INDUSTRIES AND SERVICES OF MARYLAND REPACKAGES**  
24 **BUT DOES NOT MAKE OR MANUFACTURE.**

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
26 October 1, 2017.
