SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act (Baltimore County)

ZA03 LOCAL HOUSE OF DELEGATES INITIATIVES

(AD) Morning Star Family Life Center. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$125,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of MSBC Five Star Program,

Inc., AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MORNING STAR BAPTIST CHURCH OF BALTIMORE COUNTY for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Morning Star Life Center. located in Baltimore Family County. Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act (Baltimore County) 125,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
