10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)							

The College of Southern Maryland is a regional community college serving Calvert, Charles and St. Marys counties. CSM serves more than 25,000 credit and continuing education students at its campuses in Leonardtown, La Plata and Prince Frederick, and other facilities including the Waldorf Center for Higher Education, the Center for Trades and Energy Training, and the Center for Transportation Training in La Plata. The college recently dedicated a new fourth campus, the Regional Hughesville Campus, that is centrally located to provide specialized offerings and programs to serve the region in a more cost-effective and convenient way. CSM offers a variety of flexible learning options, including web-based courses, self-paced courses, web-hybrid blended courses, and mini-sessions.

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

Redesign, renovate and expand the Southern Maryland Studies Center (SMSC) located at the College of Southern Maryland's (CSM) La Plata campus. The SMSC was established in 1976 as an archival repository for the community to collect, preserve, promote, and provide access to materials that document the culture and development of this region. The SMSC holds over 225 unique archival collections in its Documents Room, spanning from 1594 to the present. Collections consist of manuscript material, photographic material, records of local businesses, personal and family papers, paintings, etchings, maps, rare books, oral history interviews, and other audiovisual/born-digital materials. The SMSCs valuable and irreplaceable documents and resources are in jeopardy because of inadequate storage and environmental controls. SMSC is located in a space with inefficient HVAC system, no independent temp and humidity controls, inadequate archival storage and needs basic upgrades.

## 28. Comments

The SMSCs valuable and irreplaceable documents and resources are in jeopardy because of inadequate environmental controls. The Center is currently serviced by the library buildings

outdated and inefficient HVAC system, with no independent temperature and humidity controls. In order to meet nationally accepted standards, archives must have HVAC systems that constantly run at prescribed temperature and humidity settings with minimal fluctuation. High temperatures and high humidity, as well as large fluctuations in temperature and humidity, speed up the deterioration of most archival materials.			
In addition to a dedicated HVAC system, the Center requires specialized window treatments to reduce the entrance of damaging ultraviolet light. These will take the form of heat-plocking window films and shades.
