Fundraising, design and construction of a WWII Memorial to honor the Veterans and casualties of the second World War 1939 to 1945. The Memorial monument will be made of solid granite, with bronze plaques and relief sculptures. It will be twelve feet wide and six feet high, consisting of three granite panels on a granite base. There will be a relief sculpture and text plaques on the front along with the service and national emblems as selected by the Legion. The project is scheduled for completion in November of 2017 on the property owned by the American Legion.
