Funding will support the design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Mona Centers second floor health and wellness center, which will be operated by the University of Maryland Center for Health Equity. Recognizing the lack of healthcare facilities in Temple Hills, Maryland and the surrounding communities, as well as the associated barriers to available care for the low-income population, Catholic Charities and partners will provide patient-centered, affordable, and culturally-competent health care at the Susan D. Mona Center. The health and wellness center will feature dedicated space for physical activity classes, health education workshops, and individual therapy rooms, as well as a teaching/demonstration kitchen to provide healthy cooking and eating classes. With dental and primary care services located downstairs, our vision is for the Mona Center to serve as the medical home for hundreds of people in the community.
