10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The general mission of the Highland Park Christian Academy (HPCA) is to promote strong Christian principles in an effort to develop Ambassadors for Christ who are Ready, Respectful, and Responsible. One of the key goals for HPCA in the 2016-2017 School Year is to continue changing the culture of instruction and learning through technology. HPCA strives to be a bridge that links the secure, familiar world of home with the challenging experience of school. To provide a warm Christian environment where children can continue to grow and develop. Highland Park Christian Academy exists to educate and to nurture young people in and through the Christian faith. We are building future leaders, in the Christian faith, that are destined to make a difference.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The HPCA building is currently 33 years old and in need of several improvements. HPCA has identified the following ten capital improvement projects geared towards protecting the educational building from deterioration; improving the safety of students and staff, and enhancing the delivery of educational programs. This nonpublic school is owned by the First Baptist Church of Highland Park and operated by 44 educational staff members of the HPCA.

Construction Projects: Install new communication equipment; Renovate 13 restrooms; Replace deteriorating windows; Upgrade existing/antiquated fire alarm system; Repair/replace existing roof; Replace outdated/obsolete fire protection system for the schools kitchen; Replace ceiling tiles in each classroom; Paint the entire Academy; Additional/upgraded electrical capacities are needed to meet the current demands; Convert an office into a computer classroom.
