10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)							

The MSBC Five Star Program, Inc., an IRS 501 (c)(3) Community Development Corporation, (CDC) that partners in the West Baltimore County community with other community outreach organizations to enhance the lives of its residents. The goal of the MSBC Five Star Program, Inc. is to meet and support the needs of the community through outreach efforts, support services and community programs and activities. Located at 6665 Security Blvd., the CDC has served thousands of community members with social, educational, physical and mental health needs. Having oversight of The Renaissance Counseling Center, Morning Star Daycare Center and having managed a Teenage Abstinence Program and Transitional Housing Project, the CDC has a solid track record of community outreach and service. Its reach is limited only by current resources and the need for more operating space.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose is for the renovation of the Morning Star Family Life Center, (The FLC) to better serve the needs of the existing entities of the Morning Star Family Life Programs which include the Daycare and Early Childhood education, expanding youth tutoring and mentoring, before and after school care, Senior activities, social, financial, nutritional, aging and mental health services. The facility will also provide a State of the Art Commercial Kitchen for culinary training and food distribution, and Workforce Development, along with a community events space open to the entire community. Funding will afford the continuation of renovation, construction and HVAC revamping of the acquired property for the transition of our Early Childhood Learning Center that will accommodate 75 children by August 2017. We respectfully request the approval of this bond to expand, and continue our services toward our goals.
