## 10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

Since its founding in 1977, NCIA, a 501(c)(3) corporation, has been working on behalf of intellectually disabled adults, youth and other disadvantaged populations in Maryland. NCIA has over 600 employees and its headquarters has been in the Woodlawn area of Baltimore County since the late 1980s. One of our major programs is our Youth In Transition (YIT) School. For over 20 years, NCIA's YIT School has served the educational needs of children unable to participate in traditional school programs. We are licensed by the Maryland Department of Education. NCIA's adult program provides residential and vocational services to over 350 individuals with intellectual disabilities. NCIA's Career Development Program provides developmentally disabled adults with job readiness skills and individualized training in preparation for competitive community placement.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)
NCIA will be expanding its programs to serve both adults and youth. The NCIA facilities located at 7205 and 7130 Rutherford Road include vocational training programs and will be expanded to increase capacity to service other populations such as veterans, returning citizens and other at-risk groups. The combined facilities represent approximately 40,000 square feet. Additionally, NCIA will be moving to properties that are accessible to support individuals aging in place as well as accommodating individuals with physical disabilities.
