## **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

The City of District Heights is an incorporated municipality located in Prince George's County. The City provides police, code enforcement, youth and family services, public works, recreation, cultural and general government support to constituents and businesses located with the District Heights area. This project will enable the City to provide a tranquil outdoor area for veterans, seniors and families to reflect and share time together.

The City is also in the process of constructing a 10,800 square foot Senior Center within close proximity to the park site. Users of the new facility will be able to walk to the park and utilize its amenities.
