### 10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

#### 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation teaming up with Baltimore Parks and Recreation Department and Ben Franklin High School to develop the Baybrook Youth Development Park as a clean, safe place for youth to play and compete in south Baltimore. The Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation is commitment to work closely with the City of Baltimores Department of Parks & Recreation, Ben Franklin High School and other community based organizations to develop a multi-purpose synthetic turf athletic field at Farring-Baybrook Park. The Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation will work with the Baltimore Parks and Recreation Department to create a project design that incorporates high quality features, including synthetic turf, fencing, scoreboard, and sporting equipment. The Foundation will also manage the site plan development and approval phase of the project and manage the construction of the project.

In addition, the Foundation will be responsible for providing \$2,500,000 in financial support to the project. Once complete, the Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation will continue its commitment to the Farring-Baybrook Community through program, equipment and technical support, as available, to support programs conducted at the field by the City and its partners.

The field is part of the Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundations national Youth Development Park initiative, developed to provide at-risk youth in select neighborhoods safe places to play and learn. The goal is to develop 150 unique, multi-purpose, low maintenance fields with synthetic turf that will provide a cohesive recreational and educational experience for underserved young people across the United States.
