AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1172
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “repealing” in line 3 down through “after” in line 4 and substitute “altering the number of days within which the Department of Natural Resources is required to hold a certain hearing for”; in lines 4 and 5, strike “a certain license” and substitute “an authorization”; in line 5, after “oysters” insert “and”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 5 down through “law” in line 7 and substitute “establishing that the Department is not required to hold a certain hearing if an assistant Attorney General assigned to the Department determines that it is unable to establish the facts necessary to succeed in the hearing”; and in line 11, strike “certain provisions of”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 16 and 18, in each instance, strike the bracket; in line 16, strike “Within” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, WITHIN**”; in the same line, strike “60” and substitute “**90**”; in the same line, strike “a license” and substitute “**AN AUTHORIZATION**”; strike beginning with “**BEFORE**” in line 18 down through “**SECTION**” in line 19; and strike beginning with “**A**” in line 22 down through “**SECTION.**” in line 24 and substitute “**THE DEPARTMENT IS NOT REQUIRED TO HOLD A HEARING UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IF AN ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL ASSIGNED TO THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT IT IS UNABLE TO ESTABLISH THE FACTS NECESSARY TO SUCCEED IN THE HEARING.**”.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 4, inclusive; in line 11, after “**DEPARTMENT**” insert “**AND THE COURT**”; in line 13, strike “**3.**” and substitute “**2.**”; in

line 14, strike "Section 2 of this Act" and substitute "It"; and in line 15, strike "Section 2 of".
