AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1695

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Use of a Noose or Swastika to Threaten or Intimidate" and substitute "<u>Defacement</u>"; strike beginning with "prohibiting" in line 3 down through "Act" in line 7 and substitute "<u>defining the term "deface" for purposes of the hate crimes laws to include affixing, erecting, or placing a noose or swastika on"</u>; strike beginning with "the" in line 7 down through "persons" in line 8 and substitute "<u>hate crimes</u>"; strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13, inclusive; in line 14, strike "without" and substitute "<u>with</u>"; and in line 16, strike "10–306" and substitute "<u>10–301</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 1 through line 13 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

"10–301.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "DEFACE" INCLUDES TO AFFIX, ERECT, OR PLACE A NOOSE OR SWASTIKA ON.
 - (C) "Homeless" means:
 - (1) <u>lacking a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence; or</u>
 - (2) having a primary nighttime residence that is:

- (i) a supervised publicly or privately operated shelter designed to provide temporary living accommodations; or
- (ii) a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings.
- [(c)](D) "Sexual orientation" means the identification of an individual as to male or female homosexuality, heterosexuality, bisexuality, or gender—related identity.".
