AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 185
(Third Reading File Bill – Committee Reprint)

On page 57, under:

Heading: MARYLAND PORT ADMINISTRATION

Program: J00D00.02

Entitled: Port Facilities and Capital Equipment

In line 15, after “Appropriation” insert “, provided that \$35,120,000 of this appropriation made for the purpose of the Cox Creek Dredged Material Containment Facility (Cox Creek DMCF) Expansion and Related Projects may not be expended until the Maryland Port Administration (MPA) provides a report to the Legislative Policy Committee, the House Appropriations Committee, and the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee on current and planned State efforts to rebuild and modify the dikes at the Cox Creek DMCF. The report shall provide (1) the status of any ongoing procurements for this purpose; (2) the basis for award for each procurement; and, if awarded, (3) the awardee or awardees, the not-to-exceed dollar value of the award, the number of unsuccessful offerors, and the number of offerors who failed to meet the minimum qualifications for the procurement. Additionally, the report shall (1) address State efforts to promote the beneficial use and innovative reuse of dredge material; (2) address State efforts to engage private industry for this purpose; and (3) provide an overview of selection criteria for beneficial use and innovative reuse projects. The committees shall have 45 days to review and comment on the report before release of funds for the continued development of the Cox Creek DMCF. Funds restricted pending the receipt of a report may not be transferred by budget amendment or otherwise to any other purpose and shall be canceled if a report is not submitted”.
