AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 496

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Greywater” and substitute “Graywater”; in lines 3 and 5, in each instance, strike “greywater” and substitute “graywater”; and in line 4, after “circumstances” insert “and in accordance with certain requirements; requiring the Department of the Environment to adopt certain regulations”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 in line 16, on page 2 in line 2, and on page 3 in line 23, in each instance, strike “**GREYWATER**” and substitute “GRAYWATER”.

On page 1, strike beginning with “**A**” in line 18 down through “**(II)**” in line 19; and in line 20, strike “**(III)**” and substitute “(II)”.

On page 2, in line 1, strike “**(IV)**” and substitute “(III)”; in line 6, after “**SUBSECTION,**” insert “AND FOLLOWING THE ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS AS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION,”; in line 7, strike “**THE FOLLOWING**”; in line 8, after “**PURPOSES**” insert “INCLUDING”; and in line 14, after “**IF**” insert “THE USE IS PERMITTED UNDER REGULATIONS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, AND”.

On page 2 in lines 7, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 23, and 24, and on page 3 in lines 6, 8, 11, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 26, 28, and 29, in each instance, strike “**GREYWATER**” and substitute “GRAYWATER”.

On page 3, in line 25, strike “UNLESS THE GREYWATER IS DISINFECTED BEFORE IRRIGATION”; in line 27, after “DRIP IRRIGATION” insert “IF THERE IS ADEQUATE IRRIGATION AREA”; after line 28, insert:

“(XV) THE GRAYWATER DOES NOT RUN OFF OR POND ON-SITE;

(XVI) THE GRAYWATER DOES NOT CREATE NUISANCE CONDITIONS;”;

in line 29, strike “(XV)” and substitute “(XVII)”; in line 30, after “APPLICABLE” insert “STATE AND”; in the same line, after “REGULATIONS” insert “, INCLUDING STATE AND LOCAL PLUMBING CODES”; and after line 30, insert:

“(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.”.
