AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 237
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Smith” and substitute “Smith, and Klausmeier”; in line 2, after “Entrepreneurship” insert “Pilot Program”; strike line 3 in its entirety; in line 5, after “Learning” insert “and the Director of Education and Workforce Skills Training for Correctional Institutions”; in line 7, after “entrepreneurship” insert “pilot program with”; in line 9, after “instruction;” insert “requiring the program to be offered at a correctional institution determined by the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services; authorizing the program to be offered to enhance a certain mandatory education program or as separate classes under certain circumstances; authorizing the Council to coordinate with certain other entities that offer to provide certain resources at no cost to the State; specifying the resources that certain other entities may provide;”; and in line 11, strike “curriculum” and substitute “pilot program”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 11, after the second comma insert “SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE FUNDS,”; in line 12, after “LEARNING” insert “AND THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE SKILLS TRAINING FOR CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS”; in line 14, after “ENTREPRENEURSHIP” insert “PILOT PROGRAM WITH”; and after line 31, insert:

“(3) THE FINANCIAL LITERACY AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP PILOT PROGRAM SHALL BE OFFERED AT A CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

(4) THE FINANCIAL LITERACY AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP PILOT PROGRAM MAY BE OFFERED:

(I) TO ENHANCE THE MANDATORY EDUCATION PROGRAM PROVIDED BY THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE SKILLS TRAINING FOR CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS, INCLUDING PROVIDING GUEST LECTURERS; OR

(II) AS SEPARATE CLASSES COORDINATED WITH THE SCHEDULE OF THE MANDATORY EDUCATION PROGRAM.

(5) (I) THE COUNCIL MAY COORDINATE WITH OTHER ENTITIES THAT OFFER TO PROVIDE RESOURCES FOR THE FINANCIAL LITERACY AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP PILOT PROGRAM AT NO COST TO THE STATE, INCLUDING FROM A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION, A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, OR THE CENTER FOR EDUCATION, JUSTICE AND ETHICS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.

(II) RESOURCES THAT OTHER ENTITIES SPECIFIED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH MAY PROVIDE INCLUDE FUNDING, ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANCE, DEVELOPMENT OF THE CURRICULUM, AND INSTRUCTORS.”.
