AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1169  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 19, strike the first comma and substitute “and”; strike beginning with “subpoena,” in line 19 down through “firearm” in line 20 and substitute “subpoena in Baltimore City; including a criminal investigator designated by the Baltimore City State’s Attorney as a peace officer in the definition of police officer for purposes of provisions relating to the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission”; and after line 26, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Public Safety

Section 3–201(f)(2)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2011 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with “MEETS” in line 2 down through “TRAINING” in line 3 and substitute “IS CERTIFIED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS”; in line 11, after “CITY;” insert “AND”; in line 12, after “SUBPOENA” insert “IN BALTIMORE CITY”; in line 14, strike “; AND” and substitute a period; and strike lines 15 and 16 in their entirety and substitute:

(iv) a Montgomery County fire and explosive investigator as defined in § 2-208.1 of the Criminal Procedure Article;

(v) an Anne Arundel County or City of Annapolis fire and explosive investigator as defined in § 2-208.2 of the Criminal Procedure Article;

(vi) a Prince George's County fire and explosive investigator as defined in § 2-208.3 of the Criminal Procedure Article;

(vii) a Worcester County fire and explosive investigator as defined in § 2-208.4 of the Criminal Procedure Article;

(viii) a City of Hagerstown fire and explosive investigator as defined in § 2-208.5 of the Criminal Procedure Article; [and]

(ix) a Howard County fire and explosive investigator as defined in § 2-208.6 of the Criminal Procedure Article; AND

**(X) A CRIMINAL INVESTIGATOR DESIGNATED BY THE BALTIMORE CITY STATE'S ATTORNEY AS A PEACE OFFICER UNDER § 15-403.1 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE."**
