AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 549  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 12, after “circumstances;” insert “authorizing a physician assistant, under certain circumstances, to personally prepare and dispense a drug that the physician assistant is authorized to prescribe under a delegation agreement;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 20, after “record.” insert a closing bracket; after line 20, insert:

**“(C) A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT PERSONALLY MAY PREPARE AND DISPENSE A DRUG THAT THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT IS AUTHORIZED TO PRESCRIBE UNDER A DELEGATION AGREEMENT IF:**

**(1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER § 12-102(G) OF THIS ARTICLE, THE SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN POSSESSES A DISPENSING PERMIT; AND**

**(2) THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT DISPENSES DRUGS ONLY WITHIN:**

**(I) THE SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN’S SCOPE OF PRACTICE;**

**AND**

**(II) THE SCOPE OF THE DELEGATION AGREEMENT.”;**

in lines 21 and 22, strike “sample or starter dosage”; in line 22, strike “subsection (c)” and substitute “**SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C)**”; in line 24, strike the bracket; and in line 25, strike “(C)” and substitute “**(E)**”.
