Transportation - Dedication of Structures

- FOR the purpose of adding State residency to the eligibility requirements for dedicating a bridge or another appropriate structure to a deceased member of the armed forces; repealing the requirement that the Department of Transportation establish a process by which certain persons may request that the Department dedicate a bridge or another appropriate transportation structure to a certain emergency responder; and generally relating to the dedication of bridges and other transportation structures.

- The Department shall establish a process by which a member of the General Assembly, another elected official, or any member of the general public may request that
- 21 the Department dedicate a bridge or another appropriate transportation structure under
- 22 the jurisdiction of the Department to [:
 - (1) A] A deceased member of the armed forces:

1 (1) WHO WAS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE; AND

- 2 (2) [whose] WHOSE surviving spouse, parent, or next of kin is a recipient of the U.S. Department of Defense Gold Star memorializing that the member was killed in action[; or
- 5 (2) A firefighter, law enforcement officer, or another emergency responder 6 who died in the line of duty].
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2018.
