## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning 1

## 2 Baltimore County - Public Schools - Active Assailant Event Training and Drills

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County Superintendent of Schools to conduct 4 active assailant event training for school personnel in Baltimore County each school 5 year; requiring the Baltimore County Superintendent to require certain public 6 schools to hold an active assailant event drill a certain number of times each school 7 year; requiring certain training and drills to comply with guidelines established by 8 the United States Department of Homeland Security or be consistent with available 9 best practices; requiring certain public schools to keep certain records and send a 10 copy of certain records to the Baltimore County Superintendent and the Baltimore 11 County Board of Education on or before a certain date each year; and generally 12 relating to active assailant event training and drills in Baltimore County public 13 schools.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21Article - Education
- 22 7-441.

- 1 (A) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS SHALL 2 CONDUCT ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT TRAINING FOR SCHOOL PERSONNEL IN 3 BALTIMORE COUNTY EACH SCHOOL YEAR.
- 4 (B) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL REQUIRE EACH 5 BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL TO HOLD AN ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT DRILL
- 6 THREE TIMES EACH SCHOOL YEAR.
- 7 (C) THE ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT TRAINING AND DRILLS REQUIRED 8 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:
- 9 (1) COMPLY WITH GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED 10 STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY; OR
- 11 (2) BE CONSISTENT WITH AVAILABLE BEST PRACTICES.
- 12 (D) EACH BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL:
- 13 (1) KEEP RECORDS OF THE ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT DRILLS HELD 14 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION; AND
- 15 (2) SEND A COPY OF THE RECORDS TO THE BALTIMORE COUNTY
  16 SUPERINTENDENT AND THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION ON OR
  17 BEFORE JULY 1 EACH YEAR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
