### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Prince George's County – Video Lottery Terminals – Local Impact Grant Distribution

- FOR the purpose of specifying that a certain portion of the local impact grants distributed
  to Prince George's County from certain proceeds of video lottery terminals is to be
  distributed to the Town of Forest Heights in certain fiscal years; and generally
  relating to the distribution of local impact grants from video lottery terminals in
  Prince George's County.

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1 (7)(i) The SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS  $\mathbf{2}$ **PARAGRAPH, THE** distribution under paragraph (3)(i) of this subsection to Anne Arundel 3 County, Baltimore City, and Prince George's County equals the sum of the amounts to be 4 distributed to Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, and Prince George's County divided  $\mathbf{5}$ by three.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June1, 2018.
