## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Natalie M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis Commission – Diversity

- FOR the purpose of requiring that, to the extent practicable, the members of the Natalie
   M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis Commission reflect the racial, ethnic, cultural, and
   gender diversity of the State; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally
   relating to the Natalie M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis Commission.
