17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 1 **(1)** THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS C (c) BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE OR A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE. 2 3 **(2)** For a license holder in an area bounded by Liberty Heights Avenue, Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue, the hours of sale: 4 5 [(1)] **(I)** may not begin before 9 a.m. or end after 9 p.m.; and 6 [(2)] (II) may not be extended if they begin later than 9 a.m. or end before 7 9 p.m.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1,2018.
