Business Occupations – Real Estate Appraisers – Payment by Real Estate Appraisal Management Companies

FOR the purpose of requiring an appraisal management company to pay the appraiser for 4 each appraisal or valuation assignment, except under certain circumstances; $\mathbf{5}$ decreasing the number of days after the completion of a each certain appraisal or 6 7 valuation assignment during which an appraisal management company must pay 8 the appraiser, except under certain circumstances; authorizing the Commission to 9 bring a disciplinary action for violation of a certain provision of law; making a certain technical correction; and generally relating to the payment of real estate appraisers 10 11 by real estate appraisal management companies.
