## Vehicle Laws - Multiyear Registration

- FOR the purpose of requiring, rather than authorizing, the Motor Vehicle Administration to adopt a system of multiyear vehicle registration; requiring that the system of multiyear vehicle registration adopted by the Administration include certain options for the duration of a registration; requiring the Administration to make certain methods of obtaining or renewing a vehicle registration available for registration for certain periods of time; and generally relating to multiyear vehicle registration.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 19 Administration [may] SHALL adopt a system of multiyear registration THAT INCLUDES

- 1 (b) Vehicle registration plates or validation tabs shall be issued and displayed in accordance with a schedule established by the Administrator.
  - (c) The fee for a multiyear registration is the same as the annual registration fee established under this title multiplied by the number of years for which the registration is issued.
- 6 (d) The Administration shall refund the registration fees upon surrender of the 7 registration card and registration plates if the return is made before the beginning of any 8 12—month registration year for which the application for refund is made.
- 9 (e) The Administration may adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this 10 section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
