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1 AN ACT concerning

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Baltimore County Board of Education - Education Transparency Act

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring actions of the Baltimore County Board of Education to be 4 taken at a public meeting, subject to a certain exception; requiring that a record of a 5 certain meeting and certain actions be made public; requiring any action of the 6 county board to be recorded by a verbal voice vote or a roll call vote of certain 7 members of the county board; requiring the county board to keep a formal record of 8 certain public meetings and make the record available for review by members of the public on request; requiring any final action of the county board to be made publicly 9 10 available on a certain website within a certain time; requiring certain actions on the 11 county board's website to include a certain description and a certain link to a video 12 recording, under certain circumstances; authorizing the county board to take certain 13 actions in a closed session in accordance with a certain provision of law; and 14 generally relating to meetings of the Baltimore County Board of Education.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 **(A)** At the first meeting of the county board in December of each year, the county board shall elect a chair and vice chair from among the members.
- 4 (B) (1) EXCEPT FOR THE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, ALL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING AND A RECORD OF THE MEETING AND ALL ACTIONS SHALL BE MADE
- 7 PUBLIC.
- 8 (2) (I) ANY ACTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE RECORDED 9 BY A VERBAL VOICE VOTE OR A ROLL CALL VOTE OF EACH INDIVIDUAL MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD WHO IS PRESENT AT THE PUBLIC MEETING.

- 14 <u>Make the record available for review by</u>
- 15 MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ON REQUEST.
- 16 (3) (I) ANY FINAL ACTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE MADE
- 17 PUBLICLY AVAILABLE ON THE COUNTY BOARD'S WEBSITE WITHIN 12 72 HOURS OF
- 18 THE TIME THE ACTION WAS TAKEN.
- 19 (II) ON THE COUNTY BOARD'S WEBSITE, EACH ACTION SHALL
- 20 INCLUDE:
- 21 1. A FULL AND ACCURATE DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTION
- 22 TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF THE MOTION OR QUESTION; AND
- 23 2. A LINK OR REFERENCE TO THE RELATED VIDEO
- 24 RECORDING OF THE COUNTY BOARD MEETING, IF AVAILABLE.
- 25 (C) THE COUNTY BOARD MAY TAKE ACTIONS IN A CLOSED SESSION IN 26 ACCORDANCE WITH § 3–305 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
