1 AN ACT concerning

Department of Housing and Community Development – Baltimore Regional Neighborhood Initiative Program – Application Requirement

FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that an application to the Department of Housing and Community Development for funds under the Baltimore Regional Neighborhood Initiative Program contain a local government resolution of support or letter of support; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the Baltimore Regional Neighborhood Initiative Program.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to 21apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or 22application to any application to the Department of Housing and Community Development 23for funds under the Baltimore Regional Neighborhood Initiative Program submitted before

24 the effective date of this Act.

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October June 1, 2018.
